



Video Lesson Course Policy

I. TUITION

a. Tuition is charged based on the plan purchased by the student:

i. Pricing

- Paid in Full: \$580.00 for the full course
- Half Course
 - \$300.00 for First Half (Units 1 – 2)
 - \$300.00 for Second Half (Units 3 – 4)
- Monthly Subscription: \$63.00 a month
 - Must be subscribed for a minimum of ten (10) months.
- All payments are final and non-refundable.

ii. Course Access and Expiration

- Each plan allows full access to the first unit of the video lesson course.
 - Each additional unit is unlocked after the successful completion of the Video Evaluations for the preceding unit.
- Access to each course expires after a set number of months.
 - Paid in Full Courses: Twelve (12) Months
 - Half Courses
 - First Half: Five (5) months
 - Second Half: Six (6) months
 - Monthly Subscription: Ten (10) months
Students may cancel their Monthly Subscription at any time for any reason during the ten (10) month period.

II. USING THE VIDEO LESSONS

a. Unit Overviews

- i. Each unit comes with an overview showing the learning goals for each lesson and the recommended time frame for completion. Rose Music Studio strongly encourages students to follow the time frame listed on each unit overview.
- ii. The start day of the course is selected by the student when they purchase their access to the course.

b. Practice Guidelines

- i. Each video lesson will end with a list of practice guidelines to guide the student in their own practice time outside of the video lesson.
- ii. The productiveness of the video lesson course is contingent on the practice that the student invests on a weekly basis as the video lessons by themselves cannot guarantee success.

c. Video Evaluations

- i. Each unit ends with a video evaluation that will be reviewed by the teacher in order to move on to the next unit.
- ii. A list of exercises and songs to be performed and recorded by the student is provided at the end of each unit overview.
 - o Each requested item must be submitted as its own video recording.
 - o Label the video recording in the following format.
 - LastName, FirstName – Song/Exercise
- iii. Each unit will have a form to where you will submit your video evaluation.
- iv. Submitting a video evaluation does not guarantee successful promotion to the next unit.
 - o The teacher(s) at Rose Music Studio will watch the submitted videos to determine if the student has mastered the course content.
 - If mastery was achieved, the teacher(s) will allow access to the next unit.
 - If mastery was not achieved, the teacher(s) will provide the student with ways to improve in order to achieve mastery of the course content.
 - A list of positive comments and constructive criticisms will be included with the teacher(s)' response.
- v. Tuition includes four video evaluations per full year course (two video evaluations for the half courses.) If additional video evaluations are required, students will have to pay a \$35 fee per video evaluation.

III. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

a. Elisha Rose and Rose Music Studio retains all intellectual property rights to the video lesson content and their accompanying books.

i. Rose Music Studio retains rights to its content, including:

iii. Students are not allowed to distribute content from the printed course materials for any purposes.

b. Students are **NOT** permitted to download video content from RoseMusicStudio.com. Violation of this policy, including copyright infringement, may result in legal action and dismissal from all courses.

c. Video lessons are intended for a single user and may **NOT** be transferred to another person.

i. Intended Users

- The user is the individual who purchased access to the course.
- The user is the person who is being granted access to the course.

ii. Setting up access to the course with the email address of the intended user (or user's parent or legal guardian) is recommended. Parents or legal guardians are encouraged to provide adequate protection measures to prevent minors (under the age of 18) from providing information willingly or unwillingly on the internet.

iii. Rose Music Studio will only review video evaluations for the intended user of the course.

- No video evaluations for additional users will be reviewed.

d. Access to the course content may **NOT** be sold to additional users.

i. Rose Music Studio will not share Personally Identifying Information (known as "PII") that is collected for the purpose of accessing video lessons.
